ECAHO Halter Classes

This show is affiliated with the European Arab Horse Show Commission (EAHSC)
Affiliation No. 102-2016/NO.

This show is governed by the [EAHSC Rules for Conduct of Shows](#) and [EAHSC Rules for Affiliation of Shows](#) (Blue Book version 2016).

All participants are kindly asked to study all mentioned rules.

The show is open to horses registered in any WAHO recognized studbook by the closing date of entries.

Title Show or A Show Champion Gold and Silver medal winners are not allowed to take part in a B show for the rest of that calendar year and the two calendar years following, unless the horse has passed from a junior to a senior category.

Geldings that have won Champion Gold or Silver medals at a Title Show or an A show cannot be shown at B shows for the rest of that calendar year and one calendar year following.

Anybody entering an overqualified horse will be liable to a fine of €600 and the horse will be disqualified.

Horses placed 1st to 5th in each class qualify for Title shows (European and World Championships, All Nations Cup, Middle East Championships).

Championships

Foal Classes (horses born in 2016)

Foals may not compete in EAHSC

Championships, nor will they qualify for any future Title or A-show. Foals must have a minimum age of four weeks at the date of the show, and must be shown at foot (with the dam) up to 6 months of age. Orphaned or rejected foals under six months may not be shown. The use of metal halters, and halters with chains is forbidden. The foals shall be held in hand for the prize giving ceremony. The foals will be judged by the comparative judging system, according to the EAHSC Rules.

Foals under six months shown in foal classes with their own mother need no special documentation, but the mother must have all necessary documents.

Foals over 6 months shown without their dam, foals from Embryo Transplant or foals with foster mothers which are shown in foal classes and do not yet have a passport, must be micro-chipped and in possession of a copy of the official Stud Book Registration form, showing the micro-chip number and the graphic description of the foal.

Amateur Handler Class

This class is open to amateur handlers/owners who would like to show their horses themselves without having to compete with professional handlers in the same class. The judges will use the comparative judging system. This is not an ECAHO Halter Class, winners will not qualify for the Championships.

Entry Restrictions:

- a. The Handler of the horse must not have been paid for showing, training or producing any horse for a third party. This includes any remuneration either as employment, casual showing, or any in-kind benefits whatsoever.
- b. Horse not to have resided on a professional yard on show or training livery in the current year.
- c. Horse not to have been shown by a professional handler in the current year.
- d. Horse not to have received regular training from a professional in the current year.
- e. Overqualified horses or handlers taking part in a class will be disqualified.

Liberty Class

The horse shall enter the ring held by its handler, at an extended walk. The handler stops the horse in a natural position in front of the judges.

Then the handler lets the horse run free for a maximum of 2 minutes. The handler has to retake his horse within 1 minute after the music stops. Any excess time results in disqualification.

Method of judging:

Type 1-20 points

Conformation 1-20 points

Movements x 2 1-20 points

Harmony and Relationship with handler 0-20 points

In the event of a tie, the higher place will be given to the horse with the most points for movements, then followed by relationship with handler, type and conformation.

Method of judging

3 judges judge each class independently from one another, and without catalogue according to the following criteria:

Type 1-20 points

Head & Neck 1-20 points

Body & Top line 1-20 points

Legs 1-20 points

Movements 1-20 points

Half points will be used. The points awarded by each judge, will be added up and divided by the number of judges.

In the event of a tie

In the event of a tie in the qualifying places of a class, the higher place will be given to the horse with the most points for type. If there is still a tie, the higher place will be given to the horse with most points for movements. Failing a decision on either of these, one judge chosen by ballot will name his/her preference.

Starting order

The show organizers will decide the starting order by ballot, and not by the order in which entries are received.

Exhibit number sheets are to be placed on the back of the handlers shirt, sweater etc. Please return them to the Show Office after use

Championships (ECAHO alternative C: New Method)

There will be three prize winners, Champion Gold medal, Champion Silver medal and Champion Bronze medal in the following categories; Junior Males, Junior Females, Senior Males, Senior Females and Geldings. The Gold, Silver and Bronze medal winners will be selected from amongst the horses which have qualified in their respective classes for each Championship. The horses placed 1st and 2nd in each class qualify for the Championships.

The Championship will be judged as follows: All the horses qualified for the Championship will enter the ring and line up according to the numerical order of their catalogue numbers. The horses will be judged individually, standing and trotting. Each judge will nominate his choice for Gold, Silver and Bronze medals together at the same time, from amongst all the horses qualified for the Championship. All Ties and Championships will be judged in accordance with the [EAHSC Rules for Ties and Championships](#).

Medication Control

Medication testing of all Gold Medal winners is not compulsory. Any horse may be tested at the discretion of the DC. All medication testing will be conducted according to [EAHSC Rules for Medication Control](#)

Show Ground & Stabling

The Show Ground

Lefdals Rideskole, the show will be held in an nice indoor arena.

Stabling

The stables (fixed boxes) are situated in the same building as the show ring, or in buildings right next to the show ring.

Stabling will be available from Thursday August 25th 12:00 pm to Monday August 29th 12:00 pm. Stables must be left Monday August 29th at latest 12:00 pm, otherwise costs will be raised.

General Information

Vaccinations

All horses must be free of infections and must come from at home stock free of epidemic diseases. They must be properly vaccinated against influenza according to the [IV. Addendum - Equine Influenza vaccination](#)

A photocopy of the vaccination certificate and passport has to be sent to the show organizer together with the entry form.

E.C. Health Document

Horses from abroad arriving at the show ground must be accompanied by E.C. health documents. Ask the veterinary service in your country.

Veterinarian

A veterinarian will be available throughout the show. Costs are to be covered by the exhibitor. Are you in the need of an veterinarian, please contact the Show Office or anyone of the Show Crew

Documents

Horses must be accompanied at the show by a horse passport containing all vaccination records.

Those horses coming from a country that does not issue a passport, must be accompanied by an official Registration document which includes a graphic description and all vaccination records.

If, when a horse attends a show, it's passport is at the Registry for any reason, then a letter from the registrar attesting to this must be provided along with a photo-copy of the passport, including the description and the vaccination records.

The entry form, together with the show schedule is a contract between the show organiser and the person who signs the entry form. That person will be held responsible for the horse in case any sanctions are imposed.

The entry form must be accompanied by a copy of the identification document of the person who signs it.

Complaints

Complaints will be dealt with in accordance with EAHSC Rules (Rules for Conduct of Shows).

The organizer reserves the right to merge, divide, or cancel classes and championships in accordance with the above-mentioned Rules for Conduct of Shows.

Liability disclaimer

The organizers shall not be liable for any death, injury, disease or damage to any person, horse or property howsoever. It is furthermore an express condition of entry that exhibitors shall indemnify the organisers against all actions, costs, claims, demands or liability, whatsoever arising from any action in which he or she may be concerned.

NAHF reserves the right to make any changes to the show schedule, or to cancel all arrangements at their discretion in the event of force majeure.

Costs

NAHF accepts no liability for exhibitors costs.

Official Handler

On the occasion NAHF's 40th Anniversary Show in 2014 and NAHF Arab Horse Show 2015 the society provided all members and exhibitors with the opportunity to get his horse professionally shown. This was a great success, so NAHF has decided to hire Matilde Fischer Jensen from Denmark, to be our official handler this year.
