ECAHO affiliated National Championships & C International Show

It is our pleasure and honor to invite you to NAHF Arab Horse Show 2026. This show is a competition for purebred arabian horses, showcasing the beauty and agility of the breed.

A top panel of international judges has been appointed for our show. We warmly welcome them, as we welcome all friends of the arabian horse. We hope that you will join us on our quest to make this a highly memorable weekend for us all!

This show is affiliated with the European Arab Horse Show Commission (EAHSC).

The show is governed by the EAHSC Rules for Conduct of Shows and Rules for Affiliation of Shows (Blue Book version 2026) and is open to horses registered in any WAHO recognized studbook by the closing date of entries.

Entry restrictions

National Championships:

The horse has to be registered in the studbook of NAHF.

C int. show: World Championship/Title/A/GCAT Champion Gold and Silver medal winners are not allowed to take part in a C int. show for the rest of that calendar year and 2 calendar years following, unless the horse has passed from a yearling to junior, or from a junior to senior category. Gold medal winners in 2 B int. or 2 C int. or 1 B int. and 1 C int. show in the same year, are not allowed to take part in a C int. show for the rest of the calendar year.

Geldings: World Championship/Title/A/GCAT Champion Gold or Silver medal winners are not allowed to take part in a C int. show for the rest of that calendar year, and 1 calendar year following.

ECAHO Halter Class

Entry fee: NOK 900

Method of Judging:

3 judges judge each class independently from one another, and without catalogue according to the following criteria:

Half points will be used.

The National Championships and C int. show will be judged together in the same class, but with individual prize giving ceremony.

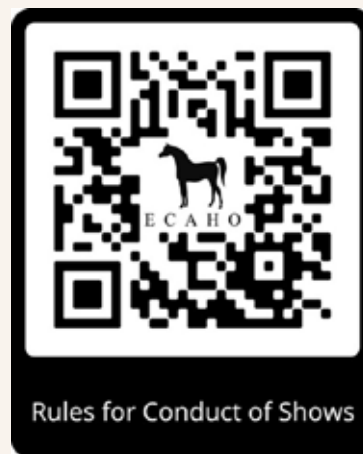

will be given to the horse with most points for type. If there is still a tie, the higher place will be given to the horse with most points for movement. Failing a decision on either of these, one judge will be chosen by ballot whose class scores will be used to break the tie.

Foal Class

Entry fee: NOK 0

Foals may not compete in EAHSC Championships, nor will they qualify for any future Title or A-show. Foals must have a minimum age of 4 weeks at the date of the show and must be shown at foot (with the dam) up to 6 months of age. Orphaned or rejected foals under 6 months may not be shown. The use of metal halters, and halters with chains is forbidden. The foals will be judged by the comparative judging system, according to the EAHSC Rules.

Foals under 6 months shown in foal classes with their own mother need no special documentation, but the mother must have all necessary documents. Foals over 6 months shown without their dam, foals from Embryo Transplant or foals with foster mothers which are shown in foal classes and do not yet have a passport, must be micro-chipped and in possession of a copy of the official Stud Book Registratio form, showing the micro.chip number and graphic description of the foal.

Championships (ECAHO alternative C: Open method)

There will be three prize winners, Gold, Silver and Bronze Champion in the following categories: Junior Females, Junior Males, Senior Females, Senior Males and Geldings.

Horses placed 1st and 2nd in each class qualify for the Championships.

Documents

Horses must be accompanied at the show by a horse passport containing all vaccination records.

The entry form, together with the show schedule is a contract between the show organizer and the person who signs the entry form. That person will be held responsible for the horse in case any sanctions are imposed. The entry form must be accompanied by a copy of the identification document of the person who signs it.

Vaccinations

All horses must be free of infections and must come from at home stock free of epidemic diseases. They must be properly vaccinated against influenza according to EAHSC IV. Addendum - Equine Influenza vaccination. [ECAHO Addendum – Equine Influenza vaccination](#)

Hereditary Disorders

The Hereditary Disorder Declaration form must be filled out by a veterinarian for all horses (except geldings) from 12 months and older. The HD Declaration form shall be presented in connection with the mandatory horse and passport check.

Complaints

Complaints will be dealt with in accordance with EAHSC Rules (Rules for Conduct of Shows).

Stabling

The stables (fixed boxes) are situated close to the show ring.

Stabling will be available from Friday June 19th 14:00 to Sunday June 21st 17:00

Boxes must be cleaned before departure.

Accommodation

We suggest that you check out hotels and camp sites in the city of Arendal and Grimstad, which are in short proximity of the show ground.

NOK 500 for the weekend for the use of electricity in connection with horse trailers/caravans at the show ground.

Breeders Evening

Saturday from 19:30 at the show ground. Dinner will be served as a buffe.

NOK 350 per person, NOK 200 per child (up to the age of 12), bring your own beverages.

NAHF shall not be liable for any death, injury, disease or damage to any person, horse or property howsoever. It is furthermore an express condition of entry that exhibitors shall indemnify the organizers against all actions, costs, claims, demands or liability, whatsoever arising from any action in which he or she may be concerned.

NAHF accepts no liability for exhibitors costs.

Customs - Border Crossing - Health Certificate

We recommend that you use an ATA-Carnet. Horses from abroad arriving at the show ground must be accompanied by an approved health certificate (TRACES or similar). Ask the veterinary service in your country.

ECAHO Breeders Fund & National Championships

EUR 300 in prize money for horses placed 1-3 in each class (classes 1-14, requires a minimum of 3 horses entered in each class).

Best Norwegian Bred Horse

Will be awarded to the horse with the highest class score. In the event of a tie, the judging panel will determine the winner based on their overall preference.
